PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED ON DRAFT PROJECT REPORT SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE Kwoiek Creek Hydroelectric PROJECT

Kanaka Bar Indian Band has made an application for a project approval certificate under the *Environmental Assessment Act* (EA Act) for the project. The application is for a 80 megawatt hydroelectric project on Kwoiek Creek approximately 14 km south of Lytton, BC, and includes a 70 km transmission line to Spatsum near Spences Bridge, BC. Draft Project Report Specifications have been prepared by the Kwoiek Creek Hydroelectric Project Committee which identify the information requirements to be addressed by the Kanaka Bar Indian Band in stage 2 of the review of this project under the EA Act.
