The Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) received an application for an environmental assessment certificate (Application) for the proposed Morrison Copper-Gold Project (proposed Project) on September 28, 2009.

In accordance with the procedures and time limits specified in the section 11 Order issued on January 18, 2008 (and subsequently amended by a section 13 Order on November 17, 2008), EAO has, with advice from the proposed Project working group (Working Group), evaluated the Application to determine if it adequately addresses each of the items identified in the approved Application Terms of Reference (TOR) that were issued by EAO on May 21, 2009.

After evaluating the Application and considering feedback from members of the Working Group, a list of deficiencies were identified (itemized in the attached table). The EAO cannot, therefore, accept the Application for formal review at this time.

Upon receipt of a revised Application, EAO will screen those sections of the Application that require changes in response to the attached table. The EAO will notify you in writing whether or not the Application has been accepted for formal review and, if accepted, provide a distribution list for submission of the Application to the Working Group.



Please be aware the Working Group commented on major issues related to water quality, hydrogeology, geotechnics, ML/ARD and specifically the lack of information relating to the long-term impacts of a collect-and-treat system on Morrison Lake. The attached screening evaluation table identifies only those major information requirements that have not been adequately addressed as per the approved TOR. However, reviewers noted other sections in the Application that will require additional clarification and information during any subsequent environmental assessment.

The EAO would be pleased to meet with Pacific Booker Minerals to discuss the attached table as well as other aspects of the Application you may wish to address before resubmitting your Application.
