**AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF THE
KITIMAT-SUMMIT LAKE PIPELINE LOOPING PROJECT
(THE PROJECT)**

ORDER UNDER SECTION 13 AMENDING SECTION 10 ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On November 23, 2005, the Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) issued an order under section 10(1)(c) of the Act, stating that the Project requires an environmental assessment certificate, and that Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. (Proponent) may not proceed with the Project without an assessment;
- B. On November 1, 2005, the Executive Director, in accordance with section 4 of the Act, delegated certain statutory and regulatory powers and duties to the undersigned Project Assessment Director;
- C. The Project constitutes a reviewable project pursuant to Part 4 of the *Reviewable Project Regulations* (B.C. Reg. 370/02) as the Project includes a new transmission pipeline facility with a diameter of > 323.9 mm and a length of \geq 40 km; and
- D. On February 23, 2006, the Proponent submitted a revised Project Description, indicating changes to the Project relating to location, length and diameter of pipeline.

NOW THEREFORE:

Pursuant to section 13 of the Act, I order that the section 10 order of November 23, 2005, be amended as follows:

- Replace “the construction of approximately 500 km of 610 mm (24 inch) diameter pipe and include the installation of a new compressor station south of Terrace and the upgrading of existing PNG compressor station facilities” with “the construction of approximately 470 km of 762 mm (30 inch) diameter pipe and include the installation of one or more new compressor stations along the pipeline”.
