### **Garibaldi at Squamish Project (the Project) Summary of Outstanding Information Requirements**

<b>Provincial Requirements</b>
Provide a summary of new federal and provincial legislation that applies to the Project.
Update the Socioeconomic Impact Assessment
Identify opportunities to incorporate smart growth and other sustainability initiatives.
Provide initial schedule for submitting applications for rezoning and an Official Community Plan amendment to local government(s).
Include Traditional Environmental Knowledge if is available from the Squamish Nation and provided to GAS for incorporation into the assessment.
Complete the Archaeological Impact Assessment.
Provide a total length of road in the Project footprint.
Provide details of the Proponent's plans to link to the Squamish public transit system.
<b>Federal Requirements</b>
Provide an update of the wildlife assessment in the context of the Species at Risk legislation.
Provide confirmation that there is sufficient water supply (either from the Brohm River or other watershed) to support the Project.
Update the residual effects assessment to take into account the Sea to Sky Highway Improvement Project.
The Proponent will follow up with Environment Canada (EC) about EC's request to describe an anticipated future scenario that might result from changed climate.
Provide a separate section on the Effects of the Environment on the Project.
Baseline information to allow Transport Canada's Navigable Waters Protection Officer to determine navigability of watercourses potentially affected by project components.
