



Environmental Assessment of the Proposed Peejay Secure Landfill Project Draft Application Terms of Reference Open for Public Comment

The B.C. Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) invites the public to comment on the draft Application Terms of Reference (ATOR) for the Peejay Secure Landfill Project (Project).

Doig River Environmental Ltd. (Proponent) is proposing to develop a secure landfill in the PeeJay area at km 23.5 on the Milligan Road, approximately 105 km north of Fort St. John for the treatment and disposal of hydrocarbon- and salt-contaminated solid wastes generated from upstream oil and gas activities. The proposed Project would have a total capacity of 2,000,000 – 3,000,000 tonnes, over a projected lifetime of about 40 years.

The proposed Project is subject to review under British Columbia's *Environmental Assessment Act*, S.B.C. 2002, c.43. The purpose of the draft ATOR is to identify the information that the Proponent must include in the application for an environmental assessment certificate.

The 30-day public comment period will begin on **July 3, 2007** and end on **August 3, 2007**. Form letters, petitions or other submissions that only state a position for or against a given project cannot be considered.

After taking public comments into consideration, the EAO will finalize the ATOR and issue them to the Proponent.
