Articles of the Regulations passed from time to time under the Game Act.

10. Any game mentioned herein which is being taken in any Provincial Park designated by the Honorable the Minister of Lands and Forests shall also be taken or killed as outlined in these regulations and may be taken in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests under any regulation of that Department.

(Note.—Under Provincial Parks Regulations, 1939, as amended by Regulation 10D, issued by Order in Council No. 1203, approved May 20, 1939, the Minister of Lands and Forests requires that no deer, second caribou, goat or baw shall be removed from Wild Game Provincial Park except when such animal bears a sealed tag. Animals, without exception, from the Park brought or from provincial stations at Kamood Lake, Clearwater Lake, and Inlet Lake.)

11. (a) All of the provisions of these regulations shall apply to the taking or killing of any game in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests, whether or not such game is taken or killed in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests, and to the taking or killing of any game in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests, whether or not such game is taken or killed in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests.

(b) Each and every person shooting, killing, or taking a pheasant shall immediately upon taking possession of same affix around the leg, about the spur, of the said bird one of the tags issued in his favor, and such tag and tag must remain on the pheasant until it is taken to the place where it is proposed to examine the said bird.

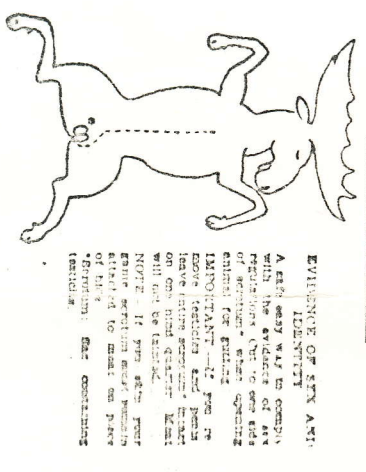
(c) For the purpose of these regulations, any pheasant having a mutilated or tampered tag on its leg shall be deemed to be an untaged pheasant.

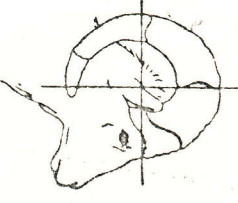
DEFINITION OF ANTILESS ANIMAL—An antiless animal is a female or young animal of the year bearing no visible beam, antlers, the small skin- or hair-covered protuberances on male horns and calves do not constitute antlers. Such animals are antiless for the purpose of these regulations. Over one year of age refers to a member of the deer family bearing visible antlers.



EVIDENCE OF SEX AND IDENTITY
A seal may be affixed to the evidence of sex and identity of any animal taken in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests, whether or not such animal is taken or killed in any Provincial Park or other area of the Department of Lands and Forests.

NOTE—If you are going to take an animal, please bring a seal with you to mark on piece of hide.

The possession of firearms by any person during the night in a place frequented by wild game birds is prohibited by the Game Act, and any person who is found in possession of any such arms during such hours shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.

OVER ONE YEAR OF AGE, in G.M.A. Nos. 20 and 21, August 15th to December 15th. In G.M.A. No. 8, September 24th to September 26th. In G.M.A. No. 7 situated and lying south of the Similkameen River and east of Ashcroft River, September 24th to September 26th. In the remainder of the Eastern District (except those portions of G.M.A. No. 7 not provided with an open season), September 1st to December 4th.

MOUNTAIN GOAT

OVER ONE YEAR OF AGE, in G.M.A. Nos. 20 and 21, August 15th to December 15th. In G.M.A. No. 8, September 24th to September 26th. In G.M.A. No. 7 situated and lying south of the Similkameen River and east of Ashcroft River, September 24th to September 26th. In the remainder of the Eastern District (except those portions of G.M.A. No. 7 not provided with an open season), September 1st to December 4th.

BOATMAN BOVES, in G.M.A. Nos. 7, 8, and 11 and in the Yale, Kamloops, Lillooet and Nelson-Creston Electoral Districts, September 3rd to September 30th.
 No person shall hunt, kill or attempt to kill any migratory game bird during the night, which, for the purpose of these Regulations, means during the period ending one half hour before sunrise and beginning one half hour after sunset and being during the hours of darkness of the following dates in those portions of the Eastern District known as Salmon Arm, North and South Okanagan, Similkameen, Yale, Grand Forks, Greenwood, and Nelson-Creston Electoral Districts:—

- (a) From September 17th to 30th 6:10 pm
- (b) From October 1st to 14th 6:09 pm
- (c) From October 15th to 31st 5:23 pm
- (d) From November 1st to 14th 5:00 pm
- (e) From November 15th to December 31st 4:53 pm

and in the remaining portions of the Eastern District the hunting of migratory game birds shall only be allowed or permissible during the period one-half hour before and one-half hour after sunset on any day.
 The possession of firearms by any person during the night in a place frequented by migratory game birds is prohibited by the Game Act and any person who is found in possession of any such arms during such hours shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.

UPLAND GAME BIRDS

CALIFORNIA QUAIL, in G.M.A. Nos. 7 and 8, October 15th to December 4th. In G.M.A. No. 7A, October 15th to November 13th.
PROVIDED that the hunting or shooting of CALIFORNIA QUAIL, in G.M.A. Nos. 7 and 8 shall be between one-half hour before and one-half hour after sunset and in G.M.A. No. 7A, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on each day of the open season.
GRONK (BLAKE), FRANKLIN'S, or GEORGE (BLAKE), commonly called WILLOW, in G.M.A. Nos. 7, 7A, 8, 9, and 12, September 17th to November 13th.
 Throughout the remainder of the Eastern District, September 17th to December 4th.

FRANKLINIAN, throughout the Eastern District, September 1st to December 4th. In G.M.A. No. 8, October 15th to December 4th. In G.M.A. Nos. 7, 7A, 9, 10, 13, and 14, September 17th to December 4th.
PARASITARY (COCK) BIRDS ONLY, throughout the Eastern District, September 1st to December 4th. In G.M.A. Nos. 7, 7A, 8, 9, 10, 13, and 14, September 17th to December 4th.
PROVIDED that the hunting or shooting of PARASITARY (COCK) BIRDS, in G.M.A. Nos. 7, 8, and 11, shall be between one-half hour before and one-half hour after sunset, and in G.M.A. Nos. 7A, 9, 13, and 14 shall be between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on each day of the open season.

DEER
BUCKS ONLY, over one year of age, throughout the Eastern District (except G.M.A. Nos. 10, 11, 15, and 10), September 17th to December 4th. In G.M.A. No. 10, September 3rd to December 11th. In G.M.A. Nos. 15 and 10, September 1st to December 1st. In G.M.A. No. 11, September 10th to December 4th.

ANTILPESS (includes DOES and all animals under one year of age), in G.M.A. No. 17, September 17th to December 4th. In G.M.A. No. 10, September 3rd to December 11th. In G.M.A. No. 15 and 10, September 1st to December 1st. In G.M.A. No. 11, September 10th to December 4th.

- (1) The cost of a single \$5.00 license for the ordinary sportsmen will be as follows:
 - a. Ordinary license
 - b. Sportsmen's license
- (2) The cost of payment of license refunds.
- (3) Upon the issuance of a duplicate license by loss or theft. Purchase of a new license is required.
- (4) All accompanied license applicants required to pay a bond in the amount specified in the Fish and Game Branch.
