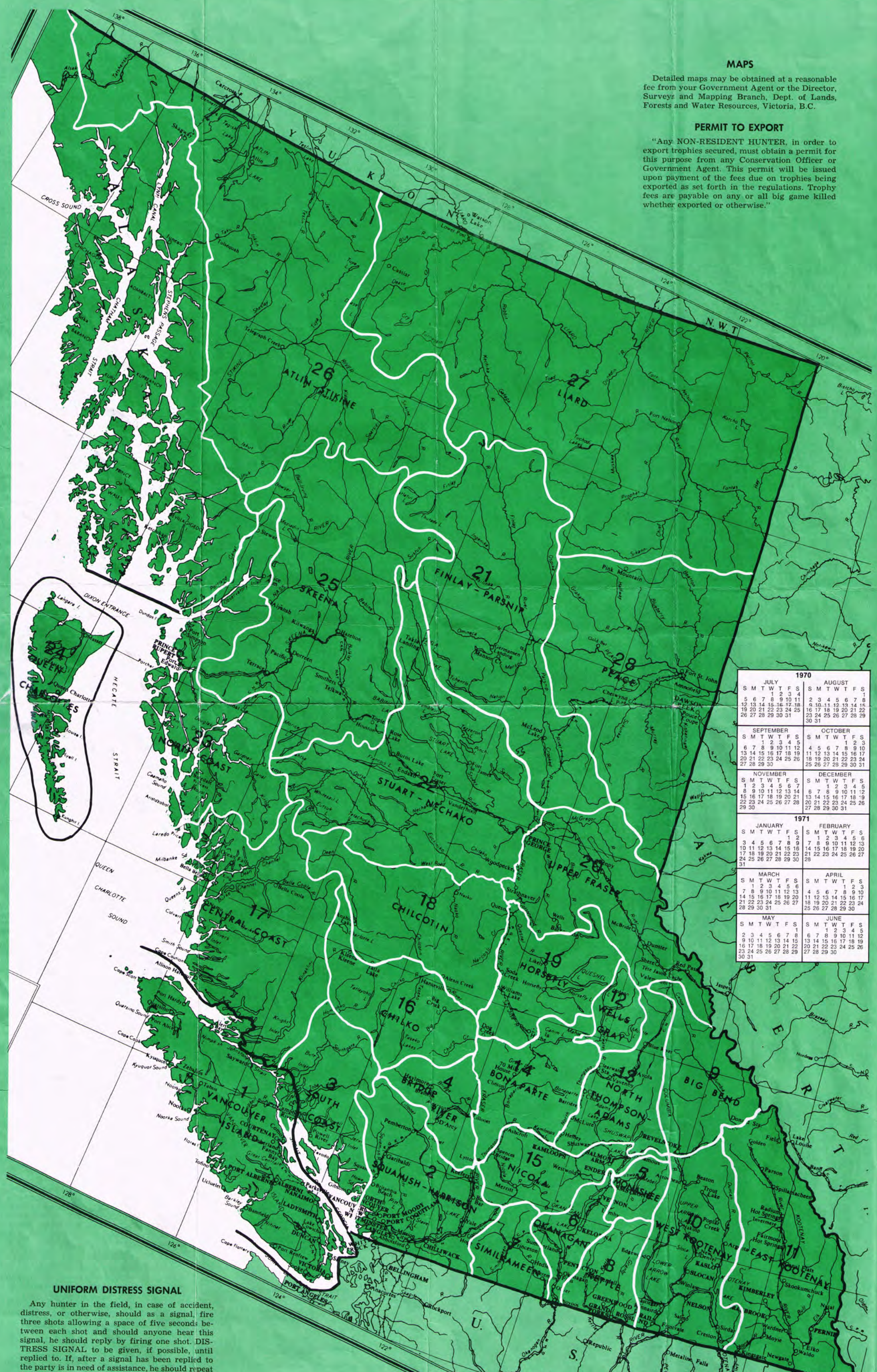


# HUNTING REGULATIONS, 1970-71



### MAPS

Detailed maps may be obtained at a reasonable fee from your Government Agent or the Director, Surveys and Mapping Branch, Dept. of Lands, Forests and Water Resources, Victoria, B.C.

### PERMIT TO EXPORT

"Any NON-RESIDENT HUNTER, in order to export trophies secured, must obtain a permit for this purpose from any Conservation Officer or Government Agent. This permit will be issued upon payment of the fees due on trophies being exported as set forth in the regulations. Trophy fees are payable on any or all big game killed whether exported or otherwise."

### GENERAL

For the purpose of defining the open seasons, for big game and game birds, the Province shall be divided into Management Areas ("M.A.") as established by Order-in-Council No. 335 approved January 27, 1967 and amended by Order-in-Council No. 1323 approved April 20, 1970.

The open seasons declared by these Regulations shall cease to be in effect in any area covered by a closure order issued by the Forest Service of the Department of Lands, Forests and Water Resources and shall continue to be ineffective during the period covered by such forest closure order.

Unless otherwise indicated all dates in these regulations and the schedules apply to the 1970 calendar year.

### OPEN SEASONS

The open seasons for the hunting or killing of each species and class of game shall be those set forth in Schedule I and Schedule II. All dates mentioned in the regulations and schedules are inclusive.

Where seasons in Schedule I do not apply to complete Management Areas they are marked by an asterisk and the applicable seasons, with descriptions of the periods and areas involved are contained in Schedule II.

### SCHEDULE II

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 1**  
Deer (including Fallow Deer). In that portion of M.A. No. 1 north of the south bank of Campbell River, John Hart Lake, Campbell Lake, Upper Campbell Lake, Thelwood Creek, Bedwell Lake, Bedwell River and Bedwell Sound, the open season for Buck Mule (Blacktail) Deer is September 5 to December 6 and Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer is November 7 to December 6; in the remainder of M.A. No. 1 the open season for Buck Mule (Blacktail) Deer is September 5 to November 15 and Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer is November 7 to November 15.

Persons hunting with bow and arrow are also permitted the open season provided by Special Regulation.

**Elk.** In that portion of M.A. No. 1 north of the south bank of Campbell River, John Hart Lake, Campbell Lake, Upper Campbell Lake, Thelwood Creek, Bedwell Lake, Bedwell River and Bedwell Sound the season for Bull Elk is October 3 to October 12.

**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear with bait is prohibited.

**Grouse (Blue).** In that portion of M.A. No. 1 south of the south bank of Campbell River, John Hart Lake, Campbell Lake, Upper Campbell Lake, Thelwood Creek, Bedwell Lake, Bedwell River and Bedwell Sound, the open season for Grouse (Blue) is August 29 to December 6.

**Parmigan.** In that portion of M.A. No. 1 south of the south bank of Campbell River, John Hart Lake, Campbell Lake, Upper Campbell Lake, Thelwood Creek, Bedwell Lake, Bedwell River and Bedwell Sound, the open season on Parmigan is August 29 to November 15.

**Throughout the remainder of M.A. No. 1 the open season on Parmigan is August 29 to December 6.**

**Pheasant.** There is no open season on Hen Pheasant in that portion of M.A. No. 1 north of the 49th parallel of latitude.

**Quail.** In that portion of M.A. No. 1 south of the Chemainus River and on Saltspring, Denman and Hornby Islands, the open season on Quail is October 10 to November 15; in the remainder of M.A. No. 1 no open season.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 2**  
**Moose.** In that portion of M.A. No. 2 east of the Fraser River and north of Highway No. 3 the open season on Bull Moose is September 12 to September 20, in the rest of M.A. No. 2 no open season.

**Mountain Goat.** There is no open season on Mountain Goat in that portion of M.A. No. 2 lying south and east of the Fraser River.

**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

**Pheasant.** There is no open season on Pheasant in that portion of M.A. No. 2 lying north of the 50th parallel of latitude and east of the Municipalities of Langley and Maple Ridge. The hunting of Pheasant is permitted from half an hour before sunrise to half an hour after sunset.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 3**  
**Deer.** Persons hunting with bow and arrow are also permitted the open season provided by Special Regulation.

**Mountain Goat.** In that portion of M.A. No. 3 known as Goat Island in Powell Lake, no open season.

**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 4**  
**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 5**  
**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

**Pheasant.** The hunting of Pheasant is permitted from 8 am to 4 pm.

**Partridge, Hungarian.** The hunting of Partridge, Hungarian is permitted from 8 am to 4 pm.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 6**  
**Mountain Sheep.** The open season on Mountain Sheep Rams, is September 19 to September 27 except in that portion of M.A. No. 6 west of Okanagan Lake and River where the open season is September 19 to October 4.

**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

**Pheasant.** The hunting of Pheasant is permitted from 8 am to 4 pm.

**Partridge, Hungarian.** The hunting of Partridge, Hungarian is permitted from 8 am to 4 pm.

**MANAGEMENT AREA No. 7**  
**Mountain Goat.** In that portion of M.A. No. 7 lying to the east of the Princeton to Merritt Highway and the Princeton to Manning Park Highway (Highway Numbers 3 and 5) and east of Manning Park there shall be no open season on Mountain Goat.

**Bear.** The hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear with bait is prohibited.

## FIREARMS RESTRICTIONS

Most Municipalities have local by-laws restricting or controlling the use of firearms within their boundaries. Hunters are advised to consult Municipal Clerks for details of closures.

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas:

- In M.A. No. 1 known as Royal Roads — Glen Lake Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the Florence Lake Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the Brentwood Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the Sooke Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the B.C. Hydro Jordan River Project Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the Ganges Harbor Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as the Nanaimo Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 1 known as Princeton Island.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 2 known as the George C. Riefel Waterfowl Refuge.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 2 known as Provincial Gaol Camp No. 1.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 6 known as the Kelowna Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 6 known as Brenda Mines Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 9 known as Mica Creek Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 11 known as Fording Mountain Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 11 known as Fording Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 11 known as Kaiser Resources Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. Nos. 13, 14 and 15 known as Kamloops Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 14 known as the Tranquille Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 15 known as the Salmon Arm Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 15 known as the Sicamous Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 15 known as the Minnie Lake Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 17 known as the Ocean Falls Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 24 known as the Fort Clements Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 25 known as the Kathleen Lake Closed Area.
- In that portion of M.A. No. 28 known as the Charlie Lake Closed Area.

The above descriptions are abbreviated and hunters are advised to contact the local authorities for specific details.

### PARK RESTRICTIONS

These hunting regulations do not apply in National Parks.

Hunting and/or the discharge of firearms is not permitted in any Provincial Class C Park nor in

### SPRING BEAR SEASONS, 1971

**Black Bear.** In M.A.'s 9 to 23 and 25 to 28 — April 1 to June 15. In M.A.'s 1 to 4 and 24 — April 1 to May 31. In M.A.'s 5 to 8 — April 1 to August 31. There is no open season on White Kermodei Bear.

**Grizzly Bear.** In M.A.'s 2 to 4 — April 1 to May 31. In M.A.'s 5 to 23 and 25 to 28 — April 1 to June 15.

### LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

ANY PERSON OF ANY AGE must take out a hunting licence if he hunts wildlife in British Columbia. There is no special fee for young people. In addition, a person under 18 must submit an acknowledgement of responsibility signed by a parent or guardian before obtaining a hunting licence. A person under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a person 19 or over when carrying a firearm.

Any person who kills any of the above big game species, must immediately cancel the appropriate tag-licence.

The possession of a big game animal without a properly cancelled tag-licence is illegal.

Cancelled tag-licence means one from which the portions bearing the month and the day of the month have been removed, by the hunter, to indicate the date the animal was killed.

The cancelled tag-licence must accompany the carcass until the carcass is at the place of consumption.

### NOTICE TO NON-RESIDENT BIG GAME HUNTERS

NON-RESIDENTS of the Province hunting big game, except coyote, must be accompanied by a licensed British Columbia guide. On the completion of the hunt non-residents must have a form of declaration. Failure to do so constitutes an offense on the part of both hunter and guide.

## BE A SPORTSMAN

- IT IS UNLAWFUL
- To use any swivel, set gun, machine gun, or any gun larger than a 10-gauge, or a pump or automatic shotgun without a plug — magazine to hold two shells.
  - To hunt any game between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, or during the prohibited time or period mentioned in the Game Regulations.
  - To carry loaded firearms in or on or discharge same from an automobile, snowmobile or other vehicle either on or off a highway.
  - To have in possession, place, or set poison for the taking or killing of any game.
  - To use pit-lamps or light of any description at any time for the purpose of hunting game.
  - To hunt game from any aircraft.
  - To use any other persons' licence or permit, or to loan or transfer any licence or permit under any circumstances.
  - To remove all evidence of sex from any member of the deer family or mountain sheep EXCEPT:
    - at the place where the carcass is to be consumed; or
    - during the open season on both sexes.
  - To angle for fish in non-tidal waters without a licence.
  - To take badger, beaver, fisher, marten, mink, muskrat, otter, squirrel or weasel unless you are the holder of a trapper's licence.

### UNIFORM DISTRESS SIGNAL

Any hunter in the field, in case of accident, distress, or otherwise, should as a signal, fire three shots allowing a space of five seconds between each shot and should anyone hear this signal, he should reply by firing one shot. DISTRESS SIGNAL to be given, if possible, until replied to. If, after a signal has been replied to the party is in need of assistance, he should repeat his first signal, but if not in need of assistance it will not be necessary to repeat signal.

**BAG LIMITS**

Bag limits for M.A.'s are set forth in Schedule III.

In Schedule III, the unbracketed number indicates the total number of animals of that species that may be taken in a given M.A., while the number in brackets designates the number of antlerless or female animals which may be taken. Thus, in the case of an area indicated as 3(2), a hunter may take three animals in total, of which a maximum of two may be antlerless or female.

Where special restrictions exist as to species, sex or age, they are marked by an asterisk and the applicable restriction is set forth in Schedule IV.

Where no bag limit is in effect, it is abbreviated NBL in Schedule III.

Subject to exceptions the following table indicates the maximum number of each species of animal that a hunter may take in each season throughout the province, except deer in M.A. No. 24.

Deer. No person shall take in the aggregate more than three (3) deer in the Province except in M.A. No. 24 where there is no bag limit.

Mountain Goat. In M.A.'s 3, 4 and 12 to 19, season bag limit 2.

Mountain Sheep. In all M.A.'s with an open season males must be 3/4 curl horn or larger.

Black Bear. In M.A.'s 13 to 15, no limit.

Cougar. In M.A.'s 1, 9 to 11 and 26 to 28, two (2). In M.A.'s 5 to 8, three (3). In M.A.'s 2 to 4 and 18 to 19, five (5). In M.A.'s 12 to 15, no limit.

Wolf. In M.A.'s 20 to 23 and 25, three (3). In M.A.'s 2 to 4, 16 to 19 and 26 to 28, no limit.

Game Birds. No person while in the field either actually hunting or returning from hunting, shall have in his possession game birds in excess of three (3) times the daily bag limit.
