

British Columbia HUNTING REGULATIONS SYNOPSIS 1972-1973





FISH AND WILDLIFE BRANCH Victoria



For the purpose of defining the open seasons, for big game and game birds, the Province is divided into Management Areas (sometimes referred to as M.A.'s) being B.C. Regs. 36/37 and 116/70.

The open seasons for the hunting or killing of each species of game are shown in the schedules on the following pages. All dates mentioned thereon are inclusive.

Where open seasons do not apply to the entire Management Areas they are marked by a colour tint and the applicable restrictions are mentioned on the page opposite to the schedule under the detailed area map.

The open seasons declared by these Regulations shall cease to be in effect in any area covered by a closure order issued by the Forest Service of the Department of Lands, Forests and Water Resources and shall continue to be ineffective during the period covered by such forest closure order.

Unless otherwise indicated all dates in these Regulations apply to the 1972-1973 hunting season.

HUNTING METHODS

Firearms. Specific restrictions on the use of firearms for a given Management Area are stated on the following pages under the detailed area maps.

Further the following general regulations apply:
The use of military (hardpoint), tracer, incendiary or explosive bullets for hunting game is prohibited.

The use of rimfire cartridges for hunting big game (except coyote) is prohibited.

A rifle may be used in hunting all game birds except pheasant,

A fine may be used in nunting all game birds except pneasant, partridge, quail and migratory game birds.

Hunting with tracer or incendiary shot shells is prohibited.

Shotguns may be used only for the hunting of deer, black bear, cougar, coyote, wolf, game birds and small game.

If a shotgun is used for hunting deer it must be 28 gauge or

Park restrictions. Hunting and/or the discharge of firearms is not permitted in any Provincial Class C Park nor in the majority of

Class A or B Parks. The following are only a few of the 100 Class A or B parks where the use of firearms is prohibited: Bowron Lakes Park, Champion Lakes Park, Cultus Lake Park, Golden Ears Park, Manning Park, Mount Seymour Park, Newcastle Island Park and Strathcona Park. A complete list of these Parks is available from: Parks Branch, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.

These hunting regulations do not apply to National Parks.

Bow and Arrow may be used for hunting all big game, small

game and game birds provided exploding arrows are not used.
If a bow and arrow is used for hunting big game, the bow must have a pull greater than 40 pounds at full draw, and the arrow must be a broadhead of % inch or greater at the widest point.

Shooting hours during which the hunting of game is permitted are in general from one hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset. Exceptions are noted under the area maps on the following pages,

Baiting. Throughout the Province the hunting of Black Bear and Grizzly Bear by the placing of bait is prohibited.

Dogs. The use of dogs is permitted in the hunting of all game except Mountain Sheep, Mountain Goat and the Deer family. Exceptions to this rule are noted under the area maps.

Note. Most Municipalities have local by-laws restricting or controlling the use of firearms within their boundaries. Consult Municipal Clerks for details of closures.

Notice. It is unlawful to carry a loaded firearm in a vehicle. A loaded firearm is one containing live ammunition in the breech or magazine

Point firearms at game only.

BAG LIMITS

Season bag limits for big and small game and daily bag limits for game birds for each Management Area are shown in the schedules on the following pages.

Where special restrictions exist as to species, sex or age, they are marked by a colour tint and the applicable restrictions are mentioned on the page opposite to the schedule underneath the detailed area map.

Where no bag limit is in effect, it is abbreviated NBL.

SEASON BAG LIMITS

No person while in the field either actually hunting or returning from hunting, shall have in his possession game birds in excess of three (3) times the daily bag limit.

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

ANY PERSON OF ANY AGE must take out a hunting licence if he hunts wildlife in British Columbia. There is no special fee for young people. In addition, a person under 18 must submit an acknowledgement of responsibility signed by a parent or guardian before obtaining a hunting licence. A person under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a person 20 or over when carrying a firearm.

NOTICE TO NON-RESIDENT BIG GAME HUNTERS

NON-RESIDENTS of the Province hunting big game, except coyote, must be accompanied by a licenced British Columbia guide. On the completion of the hunt non-residents must have a completed form of declaration. Failure to do so constitutes an offense on the part of both hunter and guide.

TAG LICENCE FEES

Big-Game Tag-Licences:

Persons hunting big game are required to take out the proper taglicences for the desired species before they start hunting. GRIZZLY BEAR \$10.00 COUGAR \$ 5.00 MOOSE \$ 6.00 MOUNTAIN GOAT MOUNTAIN SHEEP \$

immediately cancel the appropriate tag-licence.

The possession of a big game animal without a properly cancelled tag-licence is illegal.

Cancelled tag-licence means one from which the portions bearing the month and the day of the month have been removed, by the hunter, to indicate the date the animal was killed.

The cancelled tag-licence must accompany the carcass until the carcass is at the place of consumption. ALL LICENCES EXPIRE MARCH 31. (Licences issued in March

of any year expire March 31 of the following year.)

TROPHY FEES


All non-resident sportsmen are required to pay fees on any biggame animal they kill, whether or not the animal is taken from the hunting-ground.

The Fish and Wildlife Branch may in 1973 replace nonresident trophy fees with special non-resident big game tag-licences.

PERMIT TO EXPORT

All Hunters (Resident or Non-Resident) in order to export game from the Province, must obtain a permit for this purpose from any Conservation Officer or Government Agent. This permit will be issued upon payment of the fees due as set forth in the regulations. Trophy fees are payable on any or all big game killed whether exported or otherwise. (Continued on page 12)



Deer. No open season on Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer in the following areas of M.A. 1:

(a) the watershed of the south fork of the Nanaimo River;
(b) that portion of the watershed of the Chemainus River lying within the boundaries of the Mac-Millan Bloedel logging area (known locally as Copper Canyon) plus the watershed of Chipman (Boulder) Creek, and all lands between these two areas;
(c) that portion of the Gordon Piver watershed being within the boundaries of the Mac-(c) that portion of the Gordon River watershed lying within the boundaries of the Western Forest Industries Ltd. logging area;
(d) the watershed of the White River.

The special Bow and Arrow only seasons for Mule (Blacktail) Deer Bucks are Aug. 26 to Sept. 8 and

Bear. The special Bow and Arrow only seasons for Black Bear are Aug. 26 to Sept. 8 and Dec. 4 to Dec. 10. There is no Spring Bear Season in 1973.

Cougar. In that portion of M.A. 1 bounded to the south by the Mill Bay-Port Renfrew Road, and to the north by the northerly limit of the drainages of the Nitinat River, Cowichan River, and the Chemainus Rivers, the open season on Cougar is Dec. 1 to March 31. No open season within the boundaries of the Northwest Ray Division of MacMillan Rivered Ltd. Northwest Bay Division of MacMillan Bloedel Ltd. Ptarmigan. No open season south of the Parksville-Alberni Highway (Highway 4).

Quail. No open season north of the 49th parallel of latitude.

Canada Geese. Hunting prohibited in the Nimpkish Valley Canada Goose Study Area.

Mayne Island. No open season for the hunting of wildlife.

FIREARM RESTRICTIONS/HUNTING METHODS

The use of rifles for hunting is prohibited in those portions of M.A. 1 known as: North and South Pender Islands, Salt Spring Island, Saturna Island, Galiano Island, Gabriola Island, Thetis Island, the Nanaimo Special Area and Happy Valley Area.

The use of rifles or shotguns with rifled slugs is prohibited in the Highland Land District.

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas of M.A. 1 known as: Glen Lake Closed Area, Florence Lake Closed Area, Brentwood Closed Area, Sooke Closed Area, Ganges Harbor Closed Area, Nanaimo Closed Area, Protection Island, Sidney Spit Marine Park and Mayne Island.

In M.A. 1 deer may be hunted using shot shells provided they are SG. SSG or equivalent shot sizes. In M.A. 1 deer may be hunted using **shot shells** provided they are SG, SSG or equivalent shot sizes. In M.A. 1 deer may be hunted with **a dog** provided the dog is **on leash.**

The daily bag limit for Quail is five of which two may be Mountain Quail.

SPECIAL LICENCE REQUIREMENT FOR M.A. 1.

Commencing April 1, 1972, no person 14 years of age or over, whose place of residence is within Management Area No. 1 shall be issued a hunting or firearms licence unless:
(1) (a) he is 14 years of age and possesses a certificate signifying that he has successfully

completed a conservation and outdoor education program, or


(b) he is 15 years of age or over and has been issued a valid British Columbia hunting or
firearms licence subsequent to his 14th birthday, or he possesses a certificate, signifying that
he has successfully completed the conservation and outdoor education program.

(2) A person who resides within M.A. No. 1 and who is nineteen years of age or older at the time of application may be issued a firearms licence notwithstanding subsection (1) herein. NOTE: A person under fourteen years of age may obtain a firearms or hunting licence, without taking a compulsory program, provided they comply with restrictions contained in the Criminal Code and other Provincial regulations.

Moose. In that portion of M.A. 2 east of the Fraser River and north of Highway No. 3 the open season on Bull Moose is from Sept. 9 to Sept. 17; no open season in the remainder of M.A. 2.

Mountain Goat. No open season in that portion of M.A. 2 lying south and east of the Fraser River, or in the watershed of Cheekye Creek which is an easterly tributary of the Cheakamus River.

Pheasant. No open season in that portion of M.A. 2 lying east of the municipalities of Langley and Maple Ridge. The hunting of Pheasants in M.A. 2 is permitted from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.

Deer. In that portion of M.A. 3 known as Texada Island the open season for Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer is from Nov. 11 to Nov. 26. The special Bow and Arrow only season for Buck Mule (Blacktail) Deer in M.A. 3 is Dec. 4 - Dec. 10.

Mountain Goat. No open season in that portion of M.A. 3 on Goat Island in Powell Lake.

Spring Bear Seasons 1973. Black Bear: M.A. 2, 3 and 4, April 1 - May 31. Grizzly Bear: M.A. 3, April 1 - May 15. M.A. 4, April 1 - May 31.

FIREARM RESTRICTIONS/HUNTING METHODS

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) M.A. 2: George C. Riefel Waterfowl Refuge.

(b) M.A. 2: Provincial Gaol Camp No. 1.

- (c) Garibaldi Park (between Jan. 1 and August 31 of each year). Note: Hunting and/or the discharge of firearms is not permitted in that portion of Garibaldi Park lying within the watersheds of Fitzsimmons Creek and Cheakamus and Squamish Rivers.
 - (d) Pitt Polder between Feb. 1 and Aug. 31

The use of rifles or shotguns with rifled slugs for hunting is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) M.A. 2 Pitt Polder. (b) M.A. 3 Bowen and Keats Islands.

In M.A. 2 and 3 deer may be hunted using shot shells provided they are SG, SSG

or equivalent shot sizes.


Brant. No person shall hunt brant, assist persons in the hunting of brant, set out brant decoys or guide for brant on more than two successive days or on more than two days in each week, in that portion of M.A. 2 known as Boundary Bay (municipality of Delta), lying to the west of a straight line running south from Benson Road to the permanent range marker on the International Boundary that is situated approximately 1400 yards east of the shore at the village of Boundary Bay.

BAG LIMITS

Blue, Franklin and Ruffed Grouse. The daily aggregate for these three species in M.A. 2, 3 and 4 shall be ten (10) birds.

Moose. In those portions of M.A. 13 in the Adams River watershed upstream from Adams Lake and the North Thompson River watershed upstream from the confluence of the Clearwater and North Thompson Rivers, the season for Antlerless Moose is Oct. 21 to Dec. 3.

Deer. In that portion of M.A. 14 comprising the watershed of the North Thompson River the open season for Antierless Mule (Blacktail) and Antierless Whitetail Deer is Oct. 21 to Nov. 19.

Mountain Sheep. In that portion of M.A. 14 east of the junction of the Bonaparte and Thompson Rivers there is no open season.

Spring Bear Season 1973. In M.A. 12, 13, 14 and 15: April 1 - June 15 for Plack Bear and Crizzly.

for Black Bear and Grizzly.

Pheasant. In M.A. 13, 14 and 15 hunting only permitted from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Quail. In M.A. 14 and 15 hunting only permitted from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

HUNTING METHODS

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) M.A. 13, 14 and 15: Kamloops Closed Area.

(b) M.A. 14: Tranquille Closed Area and McQueen Lake Closed Area.

(c) M.A. 15: Salmon Arm Closed Area, Sicamous Closed Area and Minnie Lake Closed Area.

NOTICES

The Fish a Wildlife Branch will be operating numerous Checking Stations throughout the Province. Hunters are required to stop at all stations and report.

Report any tagged bird or animal to the Fish & Wildlife Branch, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B.C.


The Fish and Wildlife Branch may be introducing in 1973 a quota

In that portion of M.A. 7 lying within the Larcan Creek, Paul Creek and Ashnola River drainages; and in that portion lying south and west of the Similkameen River from the confluence of the Ashnola River to the International Border, the open season on Buck Mule (Blacktail) and Buck Whitetail Deer is Sept. 2 to Dec. 3.

In M.A. 8 the open season for Buck Whitetail Deer is Sept. 2 to

Oct. 22 and Nov. 18. to Dec. 3.

Mountain Sheep. In that portion of M.A. 6 west of Okanagan Lake and River the open season on Mountain Sheep Rams, 34 curl is Sept. 23 to Oct. 8.

Mountain Goat. No open season in that portion of M.A. 8 lying within the Lynch Creek and Morrell Creek watersheds.

Spring Bear Season 1973. Black Bear: April 1 - June 15 in M.A. 5, April 1 - Aug. 31, in M.A. 6, 7 and 8. Grizzly: April 1 - June 15 in M.A. 5 and 8.

Pheasant. In M.A. 5, 6, 7 and 8 hunting is only permitted from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Hungarian Partridge. In M.A. 5, 6 and 7 hunting is only permitted from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Quail. In M.A. 6 and 7 hunting is only permitted from 8 a.m. to

Grouse (Blue, Franklin and Ruffed). In that portion of M.A. 7 lying within the Larcan Creek, Paul Creek and Ashnola River drainages; and in that portion lying south and west of the Similkameen River from the confluence of the Ashnola River to the International Border the open season is Sept. 2 to Dec. 3.

FIREARMS RESTRICTIONS AND HUNTING METHODS

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) M.A. 6: Kelowna Closed Area, Brenda Mines Closed Area and Swan Lake Closed Area.

(b) M.A. 7: Similkameen Mining Co. Closed Area and the Upper Similkameen River Closed Area.

Monashee Park, The carrying of firearms of .22 calibre and the shooting of non-game animals within the boundaries of Monashee Provincial Park is prohibited.


Silver Star Park. Deer hunting only is permitted in Silver Star Park commencing Oct. 1, except in the vicinity of the ski hill, where the carrying of firearms is prohibited.

Dogs: In M.A. 5 deer may be hunted with a dog provided the dog is

on leash.

Deer. In that portion of M.A. 10 comprised of the Slocan River watershed (including all tributaries) below Slocan City there is no open season on Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer and Antlerless Whitetail Deer. In that portion of M.A. 11 comprised of the watershed of the Kootenay River between the Fort Steele Bridge and the International Boundary, except the watershed of the Elk River above Morrissey, the open season on Antlerless Mule (Blacktail) Deer is Nov. 10 to Nov. 12. In the remainder of M.A. 11 there is no open season.

Elk. In that portion of M.A. 10 comprised of the watershed of the North Arm of Kootenay Lake (including all tributaries) above the Balfor-Kootenay Bay ferry route plus that portion situated east of the South Arm of Kootenay Lake and Kootenay River (between Kootenay Bay and Rykerts) the open season on Bull Elk is Sept. 9 to Nov. 26 and on Antierless Elk is Oct. 28 to Nov. 26. No open season in the remainder of M.A. 10.

Mountain Sheep. The open season on Mature Males only is Sept. 9 to Oct. 29.

Spring Bear Seasons 1973, In M.A. 9, 10 and 11 April 1 - June 15 for Black
Bear and Grizzly.

FIREARMS RESTRICTIONS AND HUNTING METHODS

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) M.A. 9: Mica Creek Closed Area.

(b) M.A. 11: Fording Mountain Closed Area, Fording Coal Closed Area, Kaiser Resources Closed Area, Boivin Creek Closed Area, Wasa Slough and Moberly Marsh.

In M.A. 11 deer may be hunted using shot shells provided they are SG, SSG or equivalent shot sizes.



Hunters are requested to wear a blaze orange vest or other outer article of clothing when hunting big game and upland game birds. It is the intention of the Fish and Wildlife Branch to recommend legislation next year (1973) making mandatory the wearing of a blaze orange vest or outer garment when hunting upland birds and big game during general open seasons.

BE A SPORTSMAN

BE A SPORTSMAN

It is unlawful...

... to use any swivel, set gun, machine gun, or any gun larger than a 10-gauge, or a pump, repeating or automatic shotgun without a plug-magazine to hold two shells.

... to hunt any game between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, or during prohibited time or period mentioned in the Game Regulations.

... to carry loaded firearms in or on or discharge same from an automobile, snowmobile or other vehicle either on or off a highway.

... to have in possession, place, or set poison for the taking or killing of any game.

... to hunt game from any aircraft.

... to use any other persons' licence or permit, or to loan or transfer any licence or permit under any circumstances.

... to shoot game from a boat being propelled by a motor.

... to hunt or transport hunters or wildlife by helicopter.

... to keep in captivity any wildlife without a permit.

... to make a false statement to a conservation officer or constable.

... to remove all evidence of sex from any member of the deer family or mountain sheep EXCEPT:

(a) at the place where the carcass is to be consumed; or

(b) during the open season on both sexes.


... to angle for fish in non-tidal waters without a licence.

... to take badger, beaver, fisher, marten, mink muskrat, otter, squirrel or weasel unless you are the holder of a trapper's licence.

... to discharge, dump, discard or dispose of litter on any land or fresh water.

In that portion of M.A. 20 North and East of the Fraser River beginning at the confluence of the Fraser and Morhill Rivers, to the confluence of the Morkill River and Cushing Creek to Mt. Renshaw along the height of land north easterly to Mt. Pauline (Alberta border) south-easterly along the Alberta-British Columbia border to include the remainder of M.A. 20 north east of the Fraser River, but not to include Mount Robson Park, the open season for Mountain Goat is Aug. 19 to Oct. 1.

Mount Robson Park Special Area. In that portion of M.A. 20 known as Mount Robson Park the open season for Mountain Goat, Caribou Bulls, Mountain Sheep and Ptarmigan is Sept. 9 to Oct. 15.

In that portion of M.A. 21 lying north of 56 degrees north latitude the open season for the following species is:

Bull Moose: Aug. 15 to Nov. 26; Mountain Goat: Aug. 1 to Oct. 31; Bull Caribou: Aug. 1 to Nov. 26; Mountain Sheep Rams, ¾ curl: Aug. 1 to Oct. 31; Grizzly Bear: Sept. 1 to Oct. 31 and Ptarmigan: Aug. 1 to Nov. 28.

Spring Bear Seasons 1973. In M.A. 20, 21 and 23: April 1 to May 31 for Black Bear and Grizzly.

HUNTING RESTRICTIONS (M.A. 20)

Mount Robson Park. The hunting of Mountain Sheep, Mountain Goat, Caribou and Grizzly may be curtailed in 1973. General seasons on other species of game may be shortened or curtailed.



There is no open season on Mountain Goat in that portion of M.A. 25, east of Kitsumkalum River and Lake, The Cedar, Tseax and Nass Rivers, south of the Cranberry River, west of Kitwanga Lake and River and west and north of the Skeena River.

DEFINITIONS

RESIDENT means a person who is domiciled in the Province, and who has resided in the Province for the immediately preceding six (6) months.

GAME includes all big game, game birds and fur-bearing animals.

BIG GAME means any Mountain Sheep, Mountain Goat, Caribou, Elk, Moose, Deer, Grizzly Bear, Black Bear, Cougar or Wolf.

GAME BIRD means any Grouse, Part-ridge, Quail, Pheasant, Ptarmigan or migratory game bird.

SMALL GAME means certain fur-bearing animals namely Coyote, Fox, Racoon, Skunk, Wolverine, Bobcat and Lynx.

CANCELLED TAG - LICENCE means one from which the portions bearing the month and the day of the month have been removed, by the hunter, to indicate the date the animal was

EIREARMS include any gun using, as a propellent: explosives, compressed air or gas and in addition, includes air or pellet guns and long-bows or cross-

LOADED FIREARMS means any fire-arm having live ammunition in the magazine or breech.

"DEER FAMILY" means Moose, Cari-bou, Deer and Elk.

POWER BOAT means any boat, canoe or yacht powered by electric, gasoline, oil, steam or other mechanical means, but does not include a boat powered by an outboard motor which has been detached or removed from its operating position.

ANTLERLESS ANIMAL means a female or young animal of the year bearing no visible bony antlers. The small skinor hair-covered protuberances on male fawns and calves do not constitute antlers. Such animals are antlerless for the purpose of these regulations. Over one year of age refers to a member of the deer family bearing visible antlers. antlers.


MATURE RAM is a male mountain sheep which has attained the age of eight years as determined by the horn growth (annuli); OR whose longest horn has grown through a minimum of \(7\text{\text{g}} \) of a circle (315 degrees) described by the outer surface of the horn as seen from the side and including any hypermed partism. broomed portion.

34-CURL RAM is a male mountain-sheep, whose longest horn tip has grown through 34 of the circle (270 degrees) described by the outer sur-face of the horn, as seen from the

EVIDENCE OF SEX means during the EVIDENCE OF SEX means during the males only season evidence of sex is required on all members of the DEER FAMILY and MOUNTAIN SHEEP. Due to differential antlerless seasons throughout the Province, hunters are urged, for their own protection, to leave adequate evidence of sex on all Big Game animals killed.

This can best be done by:

- (a) leaving the head on the carcass;
- (b) in males, leaving a testicle or re-cognizable portion of the penis on the
- (c) in females, leaving a portion of the udder on the quarters.



OPEN SEASONS

Elk. In that portion of M.A. 28 north of the Hart Highway (Highway 97) and north of Highway 2 no open season.

Mountain Goat. In that portion of M.A. 28 bounded on

the south by the 55th parallel north latitude, on the west by the Sukunka River, on the east by the Murray River and on the north by the Pine River, no open season.

Mountain Sheep, Rams. In that portion of M.A. 28 within one (1) mile of the north shore of Williston Lake no open season.

Spring Bear Season 1973. In M.A. 27 and 28 April 1 - May 31 for Black Bear and Grizzly.

Muncho Lake Park. The hunting of game is prohibited in that portion of Muncho Lake Park lying between Mile Post 470 and 475 of the Alaska Highway (locally known that he had been Licks) as the Muncho Lake Sheep Licks).

FIREARMS RESTRICTIONS

The discharge of firearms is prohibited in that portion of M.A. 28 known as the Charlie Lake Closed Area.

Grouse (Blue, Franklin, Ruffed and Sharptail). Daily aggregate for these four species is 15 birds in M.A. 27 and 28.

ALWAYS OBTAIN PERMISSION TO HUNT ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

UNIFORM DISTRESS SIGNAL

Any hunter in the field, in case of accident, distress, or otherwise, should as a signal, fire three shots allowing a space of five seconds between each shot and should anyone hear this signal, he should reply by firing one shot. DISTRESS SIGNAL to be given, if possible, until replied to. If, after a signal has been replied to the party is in need of assistance, he should repeat his first signal, but if not in need of assistance it will not be necessary to repeat signal.
