IMPORTANT NOTICE

CHANGES TO HUNTING LICENCES AND APPLICATIONS FOR LIMITED ENTRY HUNTING

The Province has introduced a new online service for hunters in April 2016. The BC Hunting online service is designed to improve the overall efficiency of hunter services. You can use the online service to obtain your Fish and Wildlife ID (FWID) and hunting credentials, apply for Limited Entry Hunting (LEH) and track the status of your LEH application(s).

You can access the BC Hunting online service at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

DON'T WANT TO USE THE ONLINE SERVICE?

YOUR FISH AND WILDLIFE ID (FWID)

You will need a FWID to apply for LEH or to buy a hunting licence. The FWID replaces the old BC Hunter Number card. Your FWID is a permanent number linked to your personal online profile, and will be your passport to hunting services. There is no cost to get your FWID.

ALREADY HAVE A HUNTER NUMBER?

You will be assigned a FWID with hunting credentials. Your new FWID will be your old Hunter Number with three extra digits.

You can obtain your FWID by logging onto the new BC Hunting online service using your Hunter Number. You can also visit any Service BC, FrontCounter BC, or participating vendor, or by calling the FrontCounter BC Contact Centre at I-877-855-3222.

DON'T HAVE A HUNTER NUMBER OR FWID?

You'll need to register for your FWID and hunting credentials. You can register for your FWID online or in person at any Service BC or FrontCounter BC location.

NOTE: If you apply online, it can take up to three business days to process your credentials application.

LIMITED ENTRY HUNTING

Limited Entry Hunting (LEH) is a system by which hunting authorizations are awarded to resident hunters based on a lottery or random draw. The purpose of LEH is to achieve wildlife management objectives and maintain hunting opportunity.

LEH seasons are introduced where it has become necessary to limit the number of hunters or limit the number, class or sex of animals that may be harvested. The following species of game are available under LEH within certain areas of the province: Bison, Caribou, Elk, Grizzly Bear, Moose, Mountain Goat, Mountain

HOW DO I APPLY FOR LIMITED ENTRY HUNTING?

You can apply for LEH in several different ways:

- 1. Use the new BC Hunting online service: www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.
- 2. Visit any Service BC or FrontCounter BC location. You will need to bring the hunt code(s) corresponding to the hunt(s) you wish to apply for. An LEH application notes form has been provided on page 4 for your convenience.
- 3. If you already have a Hunter Number or FWID, you can also apply at a participating vendor. You will need to bring the hunt code(s) corresponding to the hunt(s) you wish to apply for.
- 4. If you have unused LEH application cards, you can use them for the Fall 2016 LEH draw by completing them and mailing them into the address on the application card. **Note:** You can only submit paper LEH application cards for the Fall 2016 LEH draw. If you have unused cards and don't want to use them for the Fall 2016 draw, you can send them in for a refund. See Submitting A Paper LEH Application section on page 2 for details.

Sheep, and Mule (Black-tailed) Deer. All of these species, with the exception of Bison and Grizzly Bear, may also be available through a General Open Season (GOS).

Although GOS may precede or coincide with LEH seasons for the same species in the same area, the class of animal available during the GOS will often be different from the class of animal available during the LEH seasons.

HOW TO USE THIS SYNOPSIS

This synopsis outlines the application process for Limited Entry Hunting. Hunting opportunities advertised in this synopsis are arranged by species, then by region, followed by class of animal, and finally by the Management Unit (M.U.) where the hunt takes place. Management Units may also be divided into zones for certain species. The "MAP SECTION" of this synopsis displays these boundaries. Where LEH occurs over an entire M.U., a map of that M.U. is **not** provided in this synopsis; for maps of M.U. boundaries, go to www.gov.bc.ca/hunting

The term 'species' as used in this synopsis refers to the type of game animal, such as Moose, Elk, Caribou, etc., and encompasses all classes, such as bulls, cows, calves, etc., of that species. For example, bull moose and an antlerless moose are considered the same species.

Each hunt is given its own unique 4-digit HUNT CODE, which is highlighted on the left of each column on each page. DO NOT use last year's LEH synopsis, as the hunt codes may change each year.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any resident of British Columbia who holds a Fish and Wildlife ID with active Resident Hunting Credentials may apply. A resident may not apply for an LEH authorization if the resident's hunting licence or resident hunting credentials have been suspended, cancelled, or the resident has unpaid fines under the Wildlife Act or the Firearm Act. Applications made by a person who is ineligible will not be entered in the draw and NO refund will be issued. Also please note that if you have moved out of the province, you must re-establish your residency in B.C. in order to be eligible.

A resident is:

- I. A person who is a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, whose only or primary residence is in British Columbia, and has been physically present in British Columbia for the greater portion of each of 6 calendar months out of the 12 calendar months immediately preceding the date of making an application under the Wildlife Act or doing another thing relevant to the operation of the Wildlife Act, or
- 2. a person who is not a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, but whose only or primary residence is in British Columbia, and has been physically present in British Columbia for the greater portion of each of the 12 calendar months immediately preceding the date of making an application under the Wildlife Act or doing another thing relevant to the operation of the Wildlife Act.

FIRST NATIONS APPLICANTS

The first priority of the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations is to ensure the long-term conservation of wildlife populations and their habitats. The Ministry is also responsible for maintaining the economic and social benefits of recreational activities and a sustainable environment.

The Ministry recognizes that First Nations may establish aboriginal rights to harvest

wildlife for sustenance (food, social, and ceremonial purposes) within their traditional areas, and that treaty First Nations have treaty rights in relation to harvesting wildlife. Those uses of wildlife must be sustainable, and harvesting methods must not jeopardize safety or the use and enjoyment of property. Any hunting of wildlife species for sale or barter, in whole or in part, is not legal, except as authorized by regulation or where there is a demonstrated aboriginal or treaty right to do so.

Under the Wildlife Act, "Indian" means a person who is defined as a status Indian under the Indian Act (Canada). Indians residing in British Columbia are not required to obtain a hunting licence or a species licence under the Wildlife Act.

Individuals who exercise an aboriginal right to hunt for sustenance purposes within a traditionally used area or who exercise treaty rights are required to comply with hunting regulations related to public health and public safety. In situations where conservation of a particular species is of concern and compliance with hunting regulations is required by individuals exercising aboriginal or treaty rights - which may include the requirement for Limited Entry Hunting authorizations - there will be prior consultation with the affected First Nations in accordance with Ministry policy and procedures. Enquiries about a traditional hunting area, practice or requirements that may apply should be forwarded to the appropriate First Nation officials or Regional Fish and Wildlife Office.

First Nations individuals who wish to hunt outside their traditionally used or treaty areas must do so in accordance with the Hunting Regulations (except for the licencing exemption described above for Indians residing in BC). This includes making application for an LEH authorization via the LEH draw. A Fish and Wildlife ID with active Resident Hunting Credentials is required to submit an application for LEH. Persons registered under the *Indian* Act (Canada) are not required to provide evidence of hunter safety training; instead, they will be granted the Resident Hunting Credentials upon confirmation of status and residency. Proof of Status includes a status card or a letter from the Band Office or First Nation Government confirming status. If applying in 2016 on paper application card, "EXEMPT" should be entered in the space allotted for Resident Hunter Number. This is required as a means of identification to prevent computer rejection of an incomplete application card. Note that LEH paper applications will be phased out in 2016.

HOW TO APPLY

Eligible residents of B.C. can apply for an LEH draw by submitting an application for each species for which they wish to be entered using the BC Hunting system www.gov.bc.ca/hunting. Hunters can also choose to submit applications through an authorized vendor, Service BC or FrontCounter BC office.

The fee for an LEH application is \$6.30, including taxes. This fee is not refundable.

SECOND CHOICES

An LEH application presents an option for you to make a second hunt choice for the SAME SPECIES. Entering a second choice is optional. If you would like to learn more about how second choices operate, please consult: www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

SUBMITTING A PAPER LEH APPLICATION CARD

Application cards are being phased out in 2016 and are no longer for sale, but if you have previously purchased an unused LEH application card, you can submit it for the Fall 2016 LEH draw. Please refer to a previous LEH synopsis for instructions on submitting an LEH application card.

If you have an unused LEH application card and do not plan to use it for the Fall 2016 LEH draw, you can request a refund by mailing your unused application card(s) to the Fish and Wildlife Branch. Refunds will be issued by cheque. To receive your refund:

- Print the word "Refund" across the front of the LEH application card. NOTE: Photocopied cards will not be accepted. You can only submit original cards.
- 2. Print your first and last name, Hunter Number or FWID (if available) and your complete mailing address in the return address area on the back of the application card. NOTE: Be sure to print clearly. Refund requests with incomplete or illegible names and/or addresses will not be processed.
- 3. If you are submitting more than one LEH application card for a refund, you can include all of them in one envelope. Please ensure that one of the application cards is correctly filled out as described in Steps I and 2 above. Only one refund cheque per envelope will be issued. Do not submit more than one name in an envelope.
- 4. Attach the correct postage and mail your request to the address provided on the LEH application card.

NOTE: Refund requests must be received no later than December 31, 2016. Refunds will take approximately 4-6 weeks to process.

WHAT AREYOUR CHANCES?

For the main draw in 2015, the Fish and Wildlife Branch processed 182,767 applications and issued roughly 26,843 authorizations for 8 species. Therefore, on average, one in every 7 applications was successful in 2015. It should be noted that odds for individual hunts could be much better, or much worse, depending on the popularity of the hunt. The LEH draw is random, like a lottery, and there are no guarantees that any individual will be successful over time.

However, if you were successful in receiving an authorization for any species except antlerless deer, your odds will be reduced. For Elk in Regions I or 2 and for Moose anywhere in the province, your odds are reduced by 66% for 3 years after being successful. For any other species (except Deer) your odds are reduced by 50% for one year only. This is called 'enhanced odds' and it reduces the number of people who receive authorizations repeatedly.

NOTIFICATION

You can check your FWID profile online at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting any time after the draw has been run to find out if you have been successful. If you are successful in the draw, you will receive your LEH authorization(s) by mail. Authorization(s) must be carried with you while hunting under the authority of an LEH authorization(s).

GRIZZLY BEAR SUBSTITUTE HUNTS

Occasionally, some Grizzly Bear hunts have so few applicants that there are hunting opportunities remaining following the initial LEH application processing. Any such left over hunts will be assigned to applicants who indicate on their LEH application(s) that they wish to be considered for a substitute hunt. An applicant should be aware that, by entering (x) in the box for a substitute Grizzly Bear hunt, they may be authorized for a Grizzly Bear hunt in an AREA (see page 4 for explanation of AREA) that is unfamiliar to them. Enhanced odds will apply in subsequent years if you are successful for a substitute hunt.

HUNTS

All hunts are open to individual applicants. Some hunts also allow for group or shared applications. Please see sections below for details about group and shared hunts.

GROUP HUNTS

Group Hunts are available to hunters who wish to apply with a group of hunting partners with the chance that every person in the group will be allotted an LEH authorization. Applicants can apply as a group of two, three or four.

Group applicants are entered in the draw as a single application based on the Group ID number assigned by the system when the first hunter in the group applies for a Group Hunt. Each subsequent hunter in the group will use the same Group ID to join the Group Hunt. If this single group application is drawn and there are enough remaining authorizations for each applicant in the group, each hunter in the group receives an authorization and each hunter may harvest an animal matching the description on the authorization. If any member of a group applying for any species except Mule (blacktailed) Deer was drawn for the same species the previous year, the entire group will have their odds reduced.

Group Hunt applications are not accepted for Elk hunts in Regions I and 2. For Moose and Bison, group hunt applications have been replaced by Shared Hunt applications (see 'Shared Hunts' section).

When applying for a Group Hunt, please be aware that the number of authorizations printed in the synopsis are tentative. In the event that there are not sufficient authorizations available to provide everyone in the group with an authorization, the group authorization will not be granted.

SHARED HUNTS

Shared hunts are for Moose or Bison only, and are intended to increase the number of people drawn for Moose or Bison without increasing the number of Moose or Bison that may be harvested in a given year. Applicants can apply for Moose or Bison as an individual, or a group of two, three or four. If any member of a group applying for a Shared Hunt has been drawn for a Moose in the previous three years or for a Bison in the previous year, then the entire group will be treated as previously successful and their odds will be reduced.

When applying for a shared Moose or Bison hunt, each member is entered in the draw individually, meaning your group has as many chances to win as there are members in the group. Groups of two will be allowed to take one Moose or Bison only, and a group of three or four will be allowed to take two Moose or Bison only. However, if only one authorization remains, and a group member from a group of three or four is selected, the group will be allowed to take one Moose or Bison only. Regardless of the number of animals the group is allowed to harvest, all group members of a successful authorization will have reduced odds the following year(s).

No group member may take more than one Moose or Bison and must cease hunting in the LEH shared hunt when he or she has harvested a Moose or a Bison, as the annual Moose or Bison bag limit for a hunter is one.

All members of the group must have a valid species licence and any group member may take a Moose or Bison until the shared limit has been reached.

Communication is necessary within the group while hunting in order to avoid exceeding the group limit. The Harvest Details section of each group member's authorization must be filled out immediately following a kill. If a member of a group cannot participate, the others may still hunt and the non-participating member(s) may join the hunt later if the group quota has not been reached, but must first update the Harvest Details section of their LEH shared hunt authorization appropriately.

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATIONS Main Draw

The deadline for the main draw (fall hunts) LEH applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. Friday May 27, 2016.

SPRING GRIZZLY AND EARLY SKEENA MOUNTAIN SHEEP DRAW

The deadline for the spring 2017 Grizzly Bear and early Skeena Mountain Sheep LEH applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. Friday February 10, 2017.

ONE APPLICATION PER SPECIES

An applicant may only enter one application per LEH species in one calendar year, regardless of the class of the animal. An exception to this regulation is for an applicant that applied for a Grizzly Bear

and/or Skeena Mountain Sheep in the spring draw. This applicant may apply for either (or both) of these species in the fall LEH draw providing that they did NOT receive an LEH authorization for that species in the spring draw.

TWO LICENCES REQUIRED

If you obtain an LEH authorization(s), you must also possess and carry your valid B.C. resident hunting licence and the appropriate valid B.C. species licence(s) while hunting under authority of an LEH authorization(s).

BAG LIMIT

An LEH authorization does not permit a person to exceed the regular hunting season bag limit for any species of game. See the current Hunting and Trapping Regulations Synopsis for information on provincial and regional bag limits. Please note that any big game animal taken by a licensed youth hunter is counted in the bag limit of the accompanying adult holder of an LEH authorization.

COMPULSORY INSPECTION

Please refer to the 2016-2018 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Synopsis for Compulsory Inspection requirements.

For information on where you can obtain a Compulsory Inspection, please refer to the 'Compulsory Inspection Centres' section on the regional pages of the Hunting and Trapping Regulations Synopsis or www.gov.bc.ca/hunting.

Anyone who kills a bull Elk or a bull Moose under the authority of an LEH authorization must, while returning from the hunt, keep the antlers of the animal available for inspection by an officer.

THIS SYNOPSIS IS NOT A COMPLETE LIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR HUNTING IN BRITISH COLUMBIA.

All persons hunting under an LEH authorization in B.C. are required to comply with hunting regulations under the Wildlife Act as outlined in the Hunting and Trapping Regulations Synopsis: www.gov.bc.ca/hunting

LIMITED ENTRY HUNTING - TERMINOLOGY

(An explanation of the column titles used in the season tables)

HUNT CODE: Each hunt is given its own unique 4-digit HUNT CODE, which is highlighted on the left of each column on each page. Hunt codes change every year.

AREA: This term is used in conjunction with a place name to denote a specific land area within British Columbia. It can consist of a number of Management Units, a single Management Unit or a portion of a Management Unit, referred to as a Zone. Hunters should be aware access is limited in some areas and are advised to confirm access before applying.

MANAGEMENT UNITS: The province is divided into 225 management units identified by number. In this synopsis they are denoted by the initials 'M.U.' and a hyphenated number, i.e. M.U. 4-24, M.U. 3-14, etc.

ZONE: Means a portion of one or more management units. If the Management Unit has been divided into Zones, this will appear as Zone A of M.U. 4-24, Zone B of M.U. 4-24, etc. Maps of Zones may be found on pages 15-27 or online at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting

SEASON DATES: Refer to a period of time that hunting may take place. All dates are inclusive, e.g., September 1 to September 30 means that hunting may commence on September 1 and continue through and including September 30.

SPECIES: In this synopsis 'species' refers to the following game: Mountain Goat, Mountain Sheep, Elk, Moose, Caribou, Mule (Black-tailed) Deer, Grizzly Bear and Bison.

CLASS OF ANIMAL: This term refers more specifically to the sex, age or antler/horn configuration of the animal for which an authorization is available.

TENTATIVE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZATIONS AVAILABLE: The number which appears in the authorizations column is a tentative number only and may be adjusted prior to the draw resulting in a possible increase or decrease in the final number of available authorizations.

FIRST CHOICE ODDS: This is a list of odds on being drawn for the same hunt in the previous LEH draw year. These odds pertain to hunts that were indicated as 'First Choice' selections on the previous year's applications. They are a measure of the number of people who applied for each authorization available in the previous year. The odds can be used as a guide to estimate your chances of winning a given draw.



Hunters should be aware access is limited in some areas and are advised to confirm access before applying.

To assist you with the transition to LEH online, we have provided an LEH Application Notes form for you, to record the information you need to apply, whether online or through Service BC, FrontCounter BC or participating vendor locations.

The Special Mountain Sheep resident draw is available to resident hunters for fall 2017.

There is only one Special resident Mountain Sheep authorization for one Mountain Sheep.

The successful applicant for the Special Mountain Sheep hunt must hold a valid resident hunting licence, a Mountain Sheep species licence and the Special Mountain Sheep authorization while hunting. Please note that, while the Special Mountain Sheep authorization allows the hunter to harvest 2 Sheep in the licence year, the hunter CANNOT hold more than one valid Mountain Sheep species licence at any one time. A second species licence may not be purchased until after the first species licence has been cancelled. If an animal is harvested during the special hunt, it will not be considered in the calculation of reduced odds for future LEH applications. All other restrictions, including the location of open seasons, weapons restrictions, species,

and sex listed in either the 2017/2018 LEH Synopsis or the 2016/2018 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Synopsis (when available) apply to this special hunt. The successful applicant need not follow horn curl regulations that apply in the area hunted as the Special Mountain Sheep authorization will be for "any ram."

In addition, the successful applicant will have the opportunity to hunt either a bighorn or thinhorn ram Mountain Sheep during the dates listed below. If hunting a thinhorn ram sheep, the successful applicant may hunt up to 21 days prior to the opening date listed below for the intended hunt region.

The non-refundable application fee for each Special Mountain Sheep application is \$15.75 (includes GST). Ten dollars from each application fee will be directed to the Habitat Conservation Trust Foundation for projects specific to Mountain Sheep Management.

Limited motorized access with snow machines is likely to be necessary for November and December but snow depths may vary greatly from year to year.

A Bison species licence will be available only by mail and a few select Service BC offices and only to those persons successfully drawn for a Limited Entry Bison authorization. Hunters are prohibited from using a weapon other than:

- a) a rifle that fires a 175 grain or larger bullet retaining 2712 joules (2000 foot pounds) or more energy at 100 metres, or
- b) a bow having a pull greater than 22.6 kg within the archer's draw length, an arrow greater than 26 grams in weight and a broadhead greater than 8.1 grams in weight and 2.2 cm in width at its widest point.

Hunters are reminded that under Section 35(2) of the Wildlife Act, anyone who kills or injures wildlife must make a reasonable attempt to retrieve that wildlife, and if it is alive, to kill it. This is particularly important with Bison.

NOTICE TO MOUNTAIN GOAT HUNTERS

Minimizing the female (nanny) harvest of Mountain Goats has been identified as an important conservation action. Previously, the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations has addressed concerns with the harvest of females through voluntary compliance among hunters to select a male Mountain Goat (billy). While the proportion of females in the harvest has decreased, there continues to be concerns over the high harvest of female mountain goats in some areas. In order to address this concern, a regulation has been implemented that states "It is unlawful to hunt a female Mountain Goat accompanying a kid or a female Mountain Goat in a group that contains one or more kids."

This regulation does not protect all female Mountain Goats as a solitary female Mountain Goat, or a female Mountain Goat within a group of goats that does not contain kids, would still be legal to harvest.




Grizzly Bear



Colour and size can be misleading

Look for a combination of characteristics

Black Bear



- **Colour** varies from blond to black.
- **Distinctive shoulder** hump.
- **Rump** is lower than shoulder hump.
- Face **profile** appears dished-in between eyes and snout.
- **Ears** are short and rounded.
- **Front claws** are 5-10 cm (2-4 inches) long, slightly curved. Claw marks are usually visible in tracks.
- **Colour** varies form blond to black, including white and blue.
- No **distinctive** shoulder hump.
- **Rump** is higher than front shoulders.
- Face **profile** is straight.
- **Ears** are tall and pointed.
- **Front claws** are less than 4 cm (2 inches) long and curved. Claw marks are not usually visible in tracks.

THE WILD SHEEP SOCIETY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA HORN CURL EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Wild Sheep Society of British Columbia has partnered with the British Columbia Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations to develop an education program for hunters relating to horn curl restrictions that apply to the harvest of wild sheep in the province.

The Society and the Ministry have become increasingly concerned about the number of illegal sheep kills occurring in British Columbia, in some cases resulting from a lack of diligence. In some cases illegal kills may result in increasing hunting restrictions (such as Limited Entry seasons in place of general open seasons) or the complete closure of a season.

In an attempt to limit the number of illegal sheep harvested in British Columbia, the Wild Sheep Society

has created a horn curl education program, with the support of the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations.

The Society's horn curl education program is divided into two sections: an education component, and a test component.

Both the Society and the Ministry highly recommend that all sheep hunters review the horn curl education program and participate in the horn curl test. Even for experienced sheep hunters this will provide a helpful review.
