



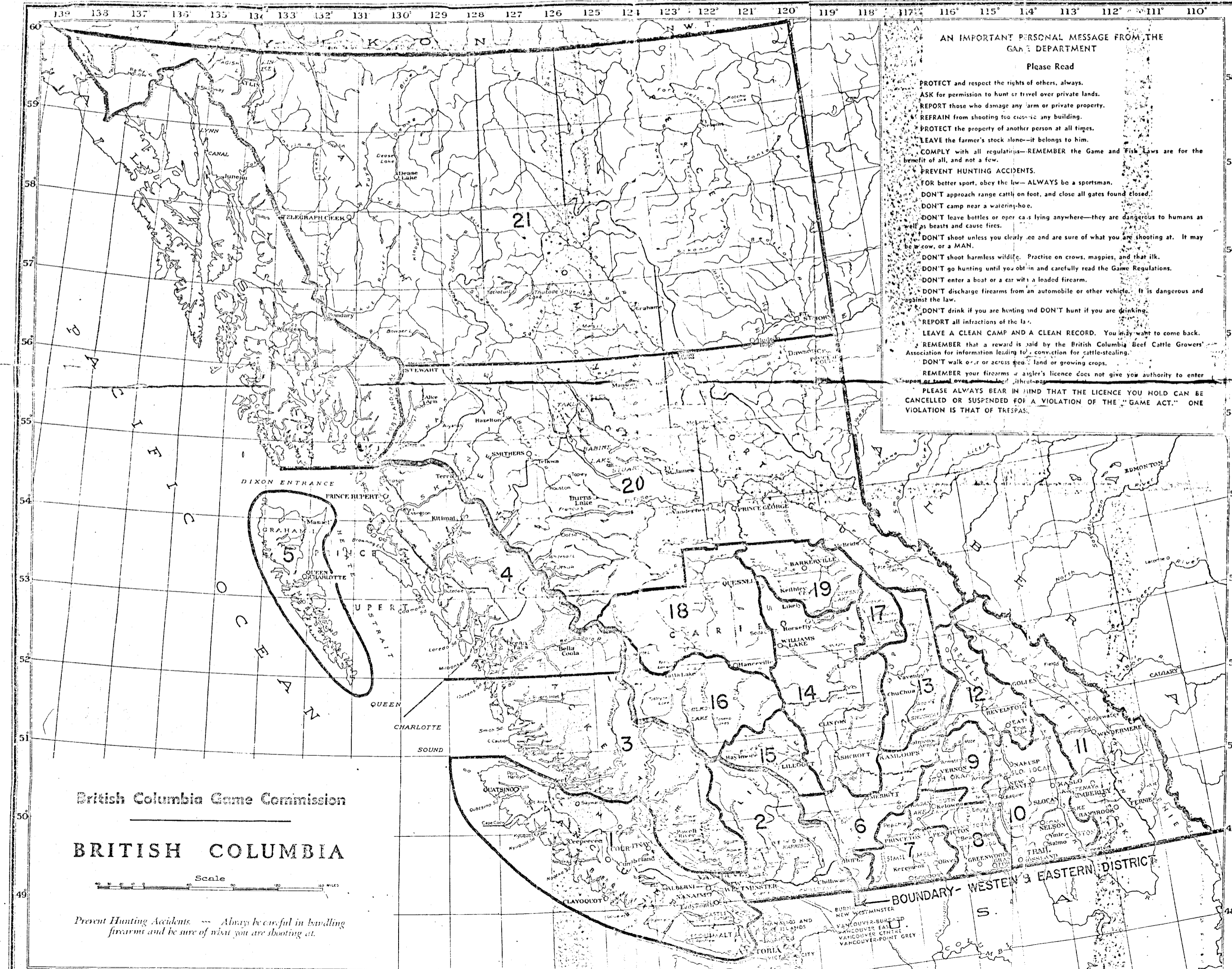


Table with columns for Game Act (G.M.A. 1 to G.M.A. 21) and rows for various game species like Big Game, Game Birds, and Ducks and Geese.

NOTICE TO SPORTSMEN

UNORGANIZED DISTRICT means any part of the Province north of the 53rd parallel of north latitude. LOADED FIREARMS: ANY FIREARM HAVING LIVE AMMUNITION in the magazine or breech is considered as loaded under the "Game Act".

AN IMPORTANT PERSONAL MESSAGE FROM THE GAME DEPARTMENT

Please Read. PROTECT and respect the rights of others. ASK for permission to hunt or travel over private lands. REPORT those who damage any farm or private property. REFRAIN from shooting to destroy any building.

NOTICE TO PROSPECTORS

A prospector as defined under the "Game Act" is as follows: "Prospector" means a person who is the holder of a free miner's certificate under the "Mineral Act" and only who is actually engaged personally in placer-mining or prospecting.

PIT-LAMPING OR NIGHT HUNTING

For the guidance of hunters, section 19 of the "Game Act" is quoted hereunder: "No person shall hunt or trap any animal or bird of prey between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise."

REGULATIONS CONTROLLING THE USE OF AIRCRAFT AND CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES IN HUNTING, FISHING, AND TRAPPING.

(1) No person shall operate any aircraft for hunting or trapping purposes or the purpose of angling without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Game Commission.

REGULATIONS COVERING THE USE OF THE BOW AND ARROW IN THE HUNTING OF GAME IN BRITISH COLUMBIA.

1. Any person hunting game with a bow and arrow, or who is carrying the same for the purpose of so hunting, must be in possession of a licence as set forth in the "Game Act".

NOTICE TO NON-RESIDENT BIG-GAME HUNTERS

"ANY NON-RESIDENT HUNTER, in order to export trophies secured, must obtain a permit for this purpose from any Game Warden or Government Agent. This permit will be issued upon payment of the fee on trophies from the Game Act as set forth in the regulations. Trophies fees are payable on any or all big game killed whether skinned or otherwise."

REGULATIONS DEALING WITH THE CANNING AND POSSESSION OF BIRD MEAT

1. For the purpose of these regulations, the words "game" and "trout" shall be defined in the "Game Act".

NOTICE TO SPORTSMEN

All sportsmen are asked to co-operate by obtaining their firearms licences early in order to assist in eliminating the usual last-minute rush. Any resident licensee (licensee) must obtain a licence for tagging any such animal or plant shot in accordance with the Game-tagging regulations.

GAME-TAG REGULATIONS

1. Each deer, moose, wapiti elk and mountain goat as defined under the "Game Act" shall immediately following the killing of such animal have a seal which has not been previously used attached to the carcass thereof, as such seal must be securely and permanently attached to the horns or other part of the carcass and must be locked by the person killing or taking it and to whom the seal has been issued in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.

IT IS UNLAWFUL

To use any swivel set-gun, slugging gun, or battery, or any gun larger than a .30-gauge, or a pump or automatic shotgun without a permanent plug-in magazine to hold two shells. To hunt any game between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, or during the prohibited time or period mentioned in the Game Regulations.

BOUNTY REGULATIONS

1. Subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, payment shall be made to any person who is the holder of a licence to carry firearms under the "Game Act" or to an Indian who has a licence within the Province, in respect to each cougar killed (520), provided that when a bonus or any other amount is payable in accordance with the regulations, the person who has been appointed in accordance with the regulations shall be entitled to receive the bonus, bounty or other amount, and it shall be necessary to make a doubly sure in this way, it will be above the usual bounty set out in the regulations.
