DISTRIBUTION AND RELATIVE ABUNDANCE

- - NOT PRESENT
- (with light stippling) - FEW (1 SHEEP PER 5-250 SQ KM)
- (with diagonal hatching) - MODERATE (1 SHEEP PER 1.3-5 SQ KM)
- (with horizontal hatching) - PLENTIFUL (OVER 1 SHEEP PER 1.3 SQ KM)
- (with vertical hatching) - RARE OR OCCASIONAL SIGHTING (SINCE 1980)
